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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- (1) All services shall be performed by persons qualified and skilled in performing such services as per the eligibility criteria indicated for the category.
- (2) The persons supplied by the Agency should not have any adverse Police records/criminal cases against them. The agency should make adequate enquiries about the character and antecedents of the person whom they are recommending. The character and antecedents of each personnel of the service provider will be got verified by the service provider before their deployment after investigation by the local police, collecting proof of identify like driving license/bank account details previous work experience, proof of to the Commissionerate. The Firm Agency will not charge any registration fee from each new contact (Daily wages) employee at the time of initial
- (3) The service provider will also ensure that the personnel deployed are medically fit and will keep in record a certificate of their medical fitness.
- (4) The Service Provider shall withdraw such employees who are not found suitable by the Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula.
- Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula from time to time. The said persons engaged by the service provider shall be the employees of the service provider and it shall be the duty of the service doing so to the Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula. The Company/Firm Agency will provide proof of receipt of wages by the workers before the end of each month. There is no Master & Servant Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula and further that the said persons of the service provider shall not claim any absorption on any ground whatsoever.
- The service provider's personnel's shall not claim any benefit/compensation/absorption/regularization of services from/ O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula under the provision of Industrial Disputes Act. 1947 or Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970. Undertaking from the persons to this effect shall be submitted by the service provider to the Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula.

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- (7) The service providers personnel shall not divulge or disclose to any person, any details of office, operational process, technical know-how, security are of confidential/ secret nature.
- (8) The service provider's personnel should be polite, cordial positive and efficient, while handling the assigned work and their actions shall promote goodwill and enhance the image of this O/o Commissioner of Income Tax for any act of indiscipline on the part of persons deployed by the Agency.
- (9) That the persons deputed shall not be below the age of 18 years and they shall not interfere with the duties of the employees of O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula.
- (10) The Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula may require the service provider to remove from the office, any person or persons, his/her/their misconduct or due to any other reason whatsoever. The service provider shall, forthwith comply with such direction and shall replace such person immediately
- (11) The service provider has to provide Photo identity Cards to the persons deployed by them for carrying out the work. These cards are to be constantly displayed by their persons & their loss reported immediately.
- (12) The service provider shall ensure proper conduct of their persons in office premises and enforce prohibition of consumption of alcoholic drinks, paan, smoking, loitering without work etc.
- (13) The transportation, food, medical and other statutory requirements in respect of each personnel of the service provider shall be the responsibility of the service provider.
- (14). Working hours would normally be 8 ½ hours per day from 9.30 AM to 6.00 PM during working days including half an hour lunch break in between. However, in exigencies of work, they may be required to sit late and personnel may be call on Saturday, Sunday and other gazetted holidays, if required. They may be paid extra wages as per the rates approved.
- (15). That the agency will be wholly and exclusively responsible for payment of wages to the persons engaged by it in compliance of all the statutory obligations under all related legislation as applicable to it from time to time including Minimum Wages Act, Employees Provident Fund Act, ESI Act etc. and the Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh shall not incur persons employed by the agency on account of any expenditure whatsoever on the The agency will have to provide particulars of EPF, ESI of its employees engaged in the O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula on monthly basis, along with bill submitted by them.

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- (16). The service provider will submit the bill, in triplicate in respect of a particular month in the first week of the next month along with copies of receipts towards EPS/ESI/Services Tax deposition for the previous month and copies of attendance register(s). The payment will be released by the third week of the following month after deduction of taxes deductible at source under the laws in force.
- (17). Payments to the service provider would be strictly on certification by the officer with whom the person deployed is attached that his services were satisfactory and his attendance certified as per the bill preferred by the service provider.
- (18). No wage/remuneration will be paid to any person for the days of absence from duty.
- (19). The service provider will have to provide the required number of additional persons for a shorter period also. In case of any exigencies as per the requirement of the O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula.
- (20). The service provider shall provide a substitute in advance if there is any probability of the person leaving the job due to his/her own personal reasons. The payment in respect of the overlapping period of the substitute shall be the responsibility of the service provider.
- (21). The service provider shall be contactable at all times and message sent by phone/e-mail/Fax/Special Messenger from the O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula to the service provider shall be acknowledged immediately on receipt, on the same day. The service provider shall strictly observe the instructions issued by Addl. Commissioner of Income Tax, (TDS) Range Panchkula, cum Chairperson Purchase committee, Panchkula in fulfillment of the contract from time to time.
- (22). The Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula shall not be liable for any loss, damage, theft burglary or robbery of any personal belongings, equipment or vehicles of the personnel of the service provider.
- (23). That the agency on its part and through its own resources shall ensure that the goods, materials and equipment's etc. are not damaged in the process of carrying out the services undertaken by it and shall be responsible for acts of commission and omission on part of its employees, etc. if the O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula suffers any loss or damage on account of negligence, default or theft on the part of the employees/agents of the agency, then the agency shall be liable to reimburse to the Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula for the same. The agency shall keep the Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula fully indemnified against any such loss or damage.

- (24). The O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula shall maintain an attendance registers in respect of the staff deployed by the agency on the basis of which wages/remuneration will be decided in respect of the staff at the approved rates.
- (25). The successful bidder shall furnish a performance Security Deposit of Rs.2,00,000/- in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt from a commercial bank/bank guarantee from a commercial bank in any acceptable form, safeguarding the interest of O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula. The security deposit shall remain valid for a

Period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the service provider. The security deposit will be forfeited, in case the supply of manpower is delayed beyond the period stipulated by the Addl. Commissioner of Income Tax, (TDS) Range Panchkula, cum Chairperson Purchase committee, Panchkula or non-compliance of the terms of agreement by the service provider or frequent absence from duty/ misconduct on the part of manpower supplied by the Agency.

- Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula for supply of suitable and qualified manpower as per requirement of this commissionerate on these terms and conditions. The agreement will be valid for a period from 01.07.2020 to 31.03.2021 from the date of contract and shall continue to be in force in the same manner, unless terminated in writing. The charges quoted by the agency (SI.No-3 of Annexure, III) shall be fixed for a period of 9 months and no request for any change/modification shall be entertained before expiry of the period of 9 months. However, in case the contract has been given at minimum wages, the minimum wages will be revised so that the same is not less than the minimum wages decided by the Government from time to time.
- (27) The service provider shall not assign, transfer, pledge or sub contract the performance of services without the prior written of this office.
- (28) The agency shall disburse the monthly salary of the workers before 7th Day of the succeeding month.
- (29) However, the agreement can be terminated by either party by giving one month's notice in advance. If the agency fails to give one month's notice in writing for termination of the Agreement then one month's wages etc. and any amount due to the agency from the O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula shall be forfeited by the O/o Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS)-2 Chandigarh at Panchkula.
- (30) On the expiry of the agreement as mentioned above, the agency will withdraw all its personnel and clear their accounts by paying them all their legal dues. In case of any dispute on account of the termination of employment or non- employment by the personnel of the agency it shall be the entire responsibility of the agency to pay and settle the same,

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- (31) In the event, if any dispute arises touching any of the clauses of the agreement, the matter will be referred to the Commissioner of Income Tax the parties.
- (32) The Agency shall be responsible for faithful compliance of the terms and conditions of this agreement. Failure of it will attract forfeiture of the performance security deposit as well as the termination of their contract and getting the work done through some outside agency at their cost and risk, during the remaining period of contract.
